## Addressing Concrete Disposal Concerns An Easy and Cost-Effective Solution

In the construction industry, federal, state and local regulations require concrete operations to dispose of residue and contaminants termed as a "concrete washout" process. Areas of disposal concern:

- Washing concrete trucks, mixers, pumps, and chutes
- Cementitious products like grout, mortar, plaster and stucco
- Activities like saw-cutting, coring, grinding and grooving
- Dust and debris from demolition projects

The wastewater from these processes is highly alkaline (pH12), caustic, and corrosive. If it is not properly managed, it can pollute groundwater and surface water by changing its pH, which increases the toxicity of other substances. This has a profound impact on our aquatic life and can inhibit future plant growth when absorbed into the soil.

Ox Bodies offers the Washout Residue body to help contain concrete and liquids during concrete operations.

- Liquids are moved through baffles to a separate cabinet area which allows water to be stored and pumped out quickly—less frequency of dumping concrete residue
- Easy on-site set up with one-step body placement—minimize time for set-up, clean-out and transit
- Roll-off body style—flexible portability to construction site or central washout station
- Swing-away tailgate and elliptical body style—quick removal

**Separate cabinet area stores liquids to be pumped out easily.**



**Watertight containment minimizes the risk of caustic wastewater being disposed of improperly.**
